• Earner to heir-Trust

1. Genesis 1:1-31 There is a God and He created the world and humans in his image.
2. Genesis 3:1-24 Man and woman disobey God separated themselves from him
3. Genesis 6:9-22 God grieves over human disobedience but provides a way of hope
4. Exodus 20:1-21 God gives His commandments to His people
5. Leviticus 4:1-35 God required offerings for the sins of his people
6. Isaiah 53 God tells of the future suffering of the promised savior
7. Hosea 3:1-5 Despite our constant unfaithfulness God provides a way for us to come back
8. Luke 1:26-38, 2:1-20 Jesus is born according to prophecy
9. Luke 5:17-26 Jesus has the authority to forgive sins and heal
10. John 3:1-21 Jesus is God's only son, sent to save the world
11. Luke 15:11-32 God longs for our return
12. Luke 18:18-29 Jesus wants us to understand the value of trusting him
13. John 11:1-44 Jesus has authority over death
14. Luke 24: 36-53 Jesus died and came back to life to fulfill prophecy and for the forgiveness of sins
15. Romans 5:1-12 Jesus' death/resurrection paid our debt to God and made our return to God's family possible
16. Acts 1:1-10 Jesus is coming back in the same way that he left
17. Acts 2:29-38 Our response is to proclaim our relationship publicly thru repentance and baptism

2. Luke 9:21-25 Following Jesus is a life of surrender
3. Luke 18:9-14 True understanding of ourself creates humility before God

5. I John 2:1-6 Obedience is God's love language
6. Psalm 119:1-8 What God says, matters most
7. Romans 12:1-2 Surrender is doing God's will
8. Proverbs 3:5-6 Obedience is trusting God rather than self
9. I Corinthians 6:12-20 My body is God's dwelling place on this earth

4. Ecclesiastes 4:9-10 Strength is found in relationships not isolation
5. Acts 2:41-47 Life together around the Bible sustains a life of healthy community
6. John 13:34-35 When love defines our relationship, Jesus is recognized as our leader
7. 1 Peter 1:22; 3:8; 4:9; 5:5 The quality of our relating to "one another" defines us as Jesus' followers
8. Ephesians 4:2; 4:32; 5:21 The quality of our relating to "one another" defines us as Jesus' followers
9. Romans 12:9-21 Obedience to Jesus is seen in our relating with love.

• **consumer to producer-Serve**

1. Luke 12:13-21 The abundant life Jesus promised is a life that is rich toward God
2. Luke 8:4-15 The fruitfulness of my life is determined by the nature of my soil
3. Romans 12:3-8 I must use the gifts God has given me to experience the riches of his family
4. Luke 19:11-28 I am entrusted by God as his steward in this world and my gifts.
5. 1 Peter 4:7-11 God's gifts are to be used for His purposes for his Kingdom
6. Galatians 3:26-29 There is no caste system in God's family all are heirs.
7. 1 Peter 2:1-9 God calls his family to be "priest" to spread his message
8. Matthew 28:16-20 We are all called to the process of making followers of Christ
9. Matthew 23:14-30 we are called to invest what God has given us for his purposes

1. Romans 8:32 God demonstrates a generous heart in gift of his Son
2. Matthew 6:19-34 We can trust God with everything we have because he shows himself trustworthy
3. Luke 18:18-30 Money is a rival God that can keep us from God's family
4. 2 Corinthians 9:6-15 Our generosity is a natural reflection of what God is doing to and for us.
5. Ecclesiastes 2:1-11 Life's pursuit apart from God leads to futility

6. Proverbs 6:6-11 Preparation and frugality are the signs of God's control of our money
7. 1 Timothy 6:6-10 The desire for money can rob us from a life with God
8. Mark 12:41-43 Great sacrifice comes out of our poverty
9. 2 Corinthians 8:1-15 It is a privilege and responsibility to give to God's work

• traveler to guide-Disciple

1. Matthew 28:16-20 Disciple making is normal for the follower of Christ
2. Luke 14:25-34 Access to life with God requires a death on a daily basis
3. II Timothy 2:1-10 Following Jesus means leaving a legacy of in the lives of others.
4. John 15:1-17 Essential to making disciple makers is learning to stay connected to the source of fruit bearing
5. Matthew 5:1-16 Transforming the internal character of a disciple is crucial to the making disciple makers.
6. 2 Corinthians 5:16-20 We have the privilege of joining God as he reconciles the world to himself.
7. Hebrews 5:11-14 Full devotion and regular growth are normal for the follower of Christ
8. Matthew 7:15-28 Doing what Jesus said is the litmus test of a disciple making disciple.
